

BC Public Service Net

Calling the British Columbia Public Service Net. Good evening - Net Control tonight is VE7_____, my name is _____ and I am located in _____. This is a directed net which meets daily at 0130 Coordinated Universal Time on 3729 kHz. as a public service. All stations are welcome and should zero-beat with this station. CW stations are asked to offset to give us a clear tone. Please do not interrupt the net except for an emergency, to contact a recent check-in or to correct an error.

Please give your station call to get Net Control's attention. If you list traffic please advise Net Control *before* leaving the frequency. The use of phonetics saves time and is strongly encouraged. It is also strongly encouraged that VOX not be utilized during this net.

During Emergency conditions the PEP frequency of 3735 kHz will be for official Government traffic only. Stations required by PEP for the passage of traffic will be contacted on the BCPSN frequency.

Additionally, in the event of an Emergency and 80 metres is not available, please tune to 7075 kHz where the BC Public Service Net would be called under such conditions.
